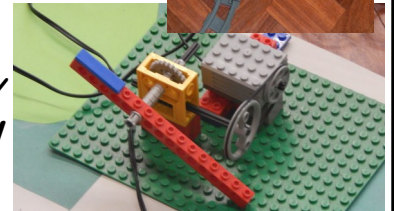
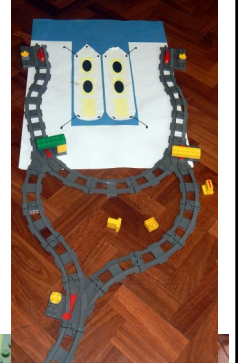
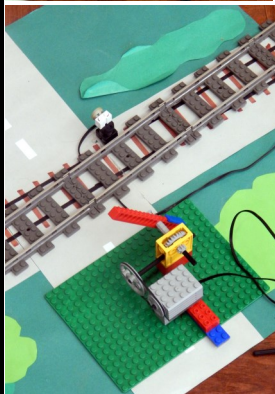
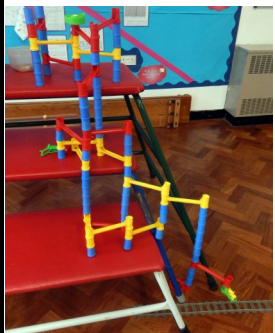


# ARNETT HILLS JMI SCHOOL
