

Dear Parents

The factors affecting the phased return of Years 2, 3, 4 and 5 are constantly changing. Although we are not in a position to implement this immediately, I am keeping this under constant review and will inform you, sooner rather than later, as the situation changes. **Next week June 22<sup>nd</sup> to 26<sup>th</sup>**

Each year group will have the chance to spend an allocated afternoon at school. Although the entire class may attend, the class will be split into 3 groups. The field, which we are fortunate to have, will be their ‘classroom.’

Monday: Year 3    Tuesday: Year 4    Thursday: Year 2    Friday: Year 5

**These class activity afternoons will happen on these days each week until the end of term on July 17<sup>th</sup> and are optional. We will fully understand and respect your decision should you not wish your child to attend.**

**Arrangements**

Children to arrive at 13:00 wearing PE kit and trainers (sun cream, sun hat etc as appropriate)

Enter via the car park IN gate. Children will be greeted at the infant playground double gate. Exit via the car park OUT gate

Please supply a packed lunch and a water bottle.

The children will eat their packed lunch on the field – picnic style. They will have a chance to see each other and chat at a socially safe distance.

**Children in Y3,4 and 5** will spend their allocated afternoon doing activities led by sports coaches with whom I have held a meeting. I am confident in the provider’s experience and understanding of Covid 19 regulations in terms of activities and resources.

**Children in Y2** will have their activities organised by Miss Wenham and Miss Brianese. This will be an ideal opportunity for them to meet Miss Brianese (and vice versa) who will be their teacher next year.

The allocated toilet facility for the boys and girls will be thoroughly cleaned at the end of the school day. Children will be reminded to wash their hands thoroughly.

Your child’s class teacher will also be present (they are all desperate to see the children).

Please use our ‘one way’ system (as described earlier) to **collect your child at 15:15** from the infant playground double gate in the car park.

I am sure that your child will have a thoroughly active, enjoyable afternoon. Please keep your fingers crossed for dry weather. I do have a wet weather back up plan ready – this will involve two bubbles rather than three.
